Historical Notes From the *Argyle Atlas*

July 29, 1898

Republican Caucus

The Republican voters of the Town of Argyle in convention assembled: The time, having again arrived for the Rep. Party of the State of WI, to place in nomination a state ticket to be voted upon in the coming fall election, and inasmuch as the Hon. Robert M. LaFollette of Madison, formerly of Argyle, a young man who grew up and was reared in this place, and of whom we should all feel truly proud, and one who is bright, intelligent and capable in every respect and possesses a great amount of executive ability, is a candidate for the place at the head of the ticket. Therefore, be it resolved that it is the sense and wish of this convention that Honorable R.M. LaFollette be nominated on the Republican ticket for Governor of this state.
